INTENDED USE

- For Cervical Cytology utilizing the Conventional Pap Smear.
- The *PAPETTE* is the most gentle, yet effective means of simultaneously taking both ectocervical and endocervical cell samples.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Contact the cervix with the *PAPETTE* and insert the central bristles into the cervical canal deep enough to allow the shorter bristles to fully contact the ectocervix.
2. Push gently, and rotate the *PAPETTE* in either direction.
3. Remove the *PAPETTE* and draw each side once across the slide (like a paint brush), thus transferring both ectocervical and endocervical cell samples in one stroke.
4. Dispose of *PAPETTE* in accordance with local Medical Hazardous Waste practices.

Note: It is advisable to inform your pathologist or lab that the Wallach *PAPETTE* is being used to obtain samples.

INTENDED USE

- For Cervical Cytology utilizing the ThinPrep® Pap Test™
- The *PAPETTE* is the most gentle, yet effective means of simultaneously taking both ectocervical and endocervical cell samples.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Contact the cervix with the *PAPETTE* and insert the central bristles into the cervical canal deep enough to allow the shorter bristles to fully contact the ectocervix.
2. While maintaining gentle pressure in the direction of the cervix, rotate the brush 5 times in a clockwise direction.
3. Rinse the brush into the PreservCyt® solution for use with the ThinPrep® Pap Test™ by pushing the brush into the bottom of the vial 10 times, forcing the bristles apart. Swirl the brush vigorously to further release material. Discard the collection device.
4. Tighten the PreservCyt® vial cap so that the torque line on the cap passes the torque line on the vial.
5. Dispose of *PAPETTE* in accordance with local Medical Hazardous Waste practices.
